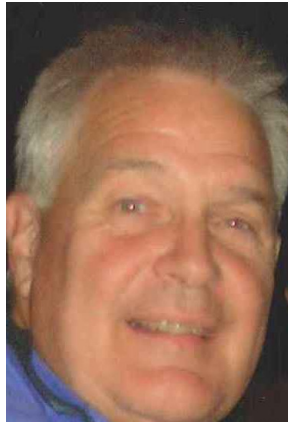
## FBC Youth Fundraiser:
