First Baptist Financial Stewardship

This year's commitment theme is "Arise and Shine." As of the first of March 116 giving units have pledged \$415,406, about 37% of our goal of \$775,500. The year 2009 year end giving showed 315 giving units giving \$719,821. We hope you will get your pledge card in as soon as possible.

January receipts were \$37,874, we spent \$49,420. We need to average \$64,625 each month to meet our goal of \$775,500 or \$14,914 each week. We recognize that we have experienced bad weather but we hope each week you will be able to get your offering in.

HVAC: We continue to make monthly payments of \$ 901.93. Our debt is \$ 245,900. We have until November 2011 to pay off our debt. We hope you will continue to give to this fund so we can retire this debt as soon as possible.
