Quarterly Business Meeting

On Wednesday, April 14, the church was called into business. Lane Gilliam from the Minister of Music search committee updated the church. The committee has placed a job description on the church web site and also received some resumes' and plan to begin the interview process in the near future.

Chuck Taylor gave a financial update. The church heard from Herb Davis and voted on the recommendation from the Mission Committee. The vote which passed was to distribute the \$7,290 from the 2009 budget: \$3,645 to Haiti Relief and \$3,645 divided 6 ways (\$607.50) to: Salvation Army, Crisis Ministry, Davidson Medical Ministries, Pastor's Pantry, Meals on Wheels, and Home Delivered Meals.
