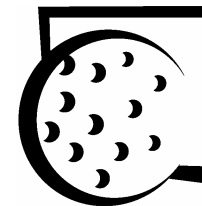

HVAC Update

The new HVAC system has been up and running for several months. The total projected budget amount for the project including contingency was \$782,065.18. After paying PI Mechanical, Triad Engineering, Central Services, TMEC and Trinity Environmental the total was \$775,508.62.

The church with funds available at the time has paid \$293,856.49. We borrowed from BB&T \$481,652.13. The rate was 5.9%. Through May 31 we have paid \$12,528.82 in interest payments only. The average payment is \$2,506, with a yearly interest payment of \$30,070. Again we are only making interest payments.

The current balance of the HVAC fund is \$77,392 as of June 15. The Finance Committee and the Deacons approved making a payment of \$41,652 to be made towards the loan. The HVAC fund is maintained at the \$30,000 level to insure payments can be made.

We hope the church will continue to give to the HVAC fund so that as excess cash is available we may continue to pay the principle and save on interest.
