The cost of the trip is approximately \$3,500 (airfare may increase due to gasoline taxes) for adults and youth. No one under the age of 18, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, may go on this trip. An \$1,800 deposit is required with the application. The deadline for initial deposit is September 1, 2008. The full amount of the trip is tax deductible.
