Building Relationships is what onCore is all About

OnCore is a four-part, midweek program based on the LOGOS System that teaches on our core beliefs. The program provides in-depth, well-rounded Christian nurture for children. It encourages the growth of the inter-generational relationships which bond the entire congregation into an authentic community of faith. onCore does not replace Sunday Church School or Worship; rather, it enhances overall church participation.

The participation of parents is critical to the success of onCore. At least one parent from each family participating is expected to help in the program. This not only provides the staffing necessary to provide an excellent experience, it demonstrates to the children their parents' belief in the importance of the Christian nurture. Nursery

Ages birth—2

A nursery is available for children ages birth through 2 years old. We operate on the school year cutoff, so children turning 2 after September 1 will remain in the nursery until next August.

Preschool

Ages 2 –3

We offer a “**Tadpole**” class for children who are 2 by September 1 and a “**Sprouts**” class for children who are 3 by September 1. Children turning 2 after September 1st will remain in the nursery program.

Preschool children will experience a modified version of onCore. They will eat, sing, play, and pray within their classrooms.

Cherubs

Ages 4—5

We use the same cutoff as the school system, so all kids who are age 4 or 5 by 9/1/08 are eligible to participate in onCore Cherubs.

Cherubs eat their dinner at their own table with table parents. They then have a Bible lesson, Choir time, Craft time, and a supervised play time.

Elementary

Kids will be divided by ages as:

1st - 2nd grade will eat, play and sing together. They will be separated during Bible Time.

3rd Grade will eat, play, and study together. They will join the 4th and 5th graders for choir.

F2 4th & 5th Grade

Children’s Choirs

Only have time for Choir.. No problem. Complete a registration form with a note “Choir Only” and return it to the Church Office. (No charge for choir)

Cherub Choir

This choir is for 4 year olds and Kindergartners. Meet in the Multi-Purpose Room.

Carol Choir

This choir is for first and second graders. They meet in the choir room located in the CLB building from 6:30 - 7:15. They will learn about participating in worship and will occasionally sing for Sunday worship services.

Chorister Choir

This choir is for children in grades 3rd through 5th. They meet from 5:30-6:15. More advanced music, part-singing and better understanding of faith through music are the goals of this group. This group also occasionally sings during worship services.

Choir Parents

The Children’s Music Ministry needs parents to help with rehearsals and putting on robes (on the Sundays they sing in worship). If you are willing to help in any way please contact the Sally Heneghan, 770/441-0625.
