---

The Episcopal Church in the United States is one of 37 self-governing member churches/provinces of the 70-million member worldwide Anglican Communion, a framework of churches linked in “bonds of affection” with the Archbishop of Canterbury. Churches of the Anglican Communion are located in some 160 countries. The Anglican Communion Office in London serves as headquarters for the Anglican Consultative Council, the Primates Meeting, and the Lambeth Conference. Every 10 years, all active diocesan and suffragan bishops convene in the Lambeth Conference, the next of which will most likely be held in 2008 in Canterbury.

## ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY

---

The Most Rev. Rowan Williams is the 104th Archbishop of Canterbury. He was enthroned at Canterbury Cathedral on 27 February 2003. Dr. Williams, who serves as Archbishop of Canterbury at the appointment of Queen Elizabeth II, previously served as Bishop of Monmouth in 1991, and was enthroned as Archbishop of Wales in 2000. The See of Canterbury traces its history from the year 597 AD and to St. Augustine as first Archbishop. The Archbishop’s Episcopal seat is Canterbury Cathedral; his official residence is Lambeth Palace, London.

#### Episcopal Seat of the Diocese of Minnesota

The Rt. Rev. Samuel Cook Edsall, second Bishop of Minnesota (1901–1917), preferred to live and work in Minneapolis, which was, second to Chicago, the fastest-growing city in the nation. To advance the shift away from Faribault (the original See City of the diocese), he also became acting rector for St. Mark's Church in downtown Minneapolis (1903-1907), in addition to his duties as diocesan bishop. When it developed that St. Mark's would have to relocate, Bishop Edsall envisioned an opportunity for a new cathedral. St. Mark's built a fitting edifice in 1910, but it wasn't until 1941 that St. Mark's was given cathedral status along with the Cathedral of Our Merciful Saviour in Faribault. The Cathedral in Faribault continues as "the historic cathedral."

#### The First Cathedral in the American Church

Of the 35 locations in Minnesota where the Episcopal Church had established its work by 1858, Bishop Whipple chose Faribault as his home and headquarters. St. Paul was larger, with a population of 10,000, and the Minneapolis area was largely unsettled, having been opened officially to non-Indians only in 1849. In 1859 the Parish of the Good Shepherd, the Episcopal church in Faribault, met in a rude chapel. The new bishop soon had thoughts of a building more in keeping with his aspirations. Nine years later the Cathedral of Our Merciful Saviour was consecrated as the first cathedral in the American Church. When Bishop Whipple died in 1901 he was buried underneath the cathedral's altar.

- Announce to the congregation the Bishop's intention to visit

- Preside at the Holy Eucharist and Initiatory Rite
- Preach the Word
- Examine the records
- Examine the life and ministry of the clergy and congregation
