Kim Kubr, The Netherlands - Church Planting

They are thanking the Lord for His direction and provisions for them to remain in the Netherlands. Kim says the Lord knew he needed to be born of Dutch parents in order for Him to serve in the Netherlands. The Lord also knew he needed to retain Dutch citizenship until his mid 20s. Kim is thankful he is able to maintain dual citizenship. In another two or three years dual citizenship may not be available, but Chis, Kim's wife, should not have any problems remaining in the country. Please pray for Chis' permanent residency approval over the next 3-6 months.

WeiChee Lam, Papua, Indonesia - Church Planting

The Lam family received new visas and thanks everyone for praying for them. They had to clear military intelligence because Papua was considered a "sensitive" province in Indonesia. The Indonesian government is concerned about foreigners influencing the locals with pro-democracy and anti-establishment ideas. The new visa actually gives them more freedom to explore ministry opportunities in the province. They hope to be in the village of Koroak permanently. They can only be there for 6 months at any point in time. This is because of the governments mistrust of foreigners. Pray for this policy to change.
