We invite you, Episcopal youth who are in grades 9-12, to submit digital images of your own art and/or your own photographic images, for possible use during worship throughout EYE. There is no guarantee that submitted work will be selected for use during EYE. All submitted images will be gathered in a youth images bank for possible use in the future. *Submissions will be used in ministry and will not be sold or used for profit.*

To submit your work:

- Create digital images of entries. All images should be in a .jpg, .png or .gif format.
- **Scanned Images:** Any resolution above 640 x 480 at 200 dpi.
- **Camera Images:** At least 2.0 megapixels at medium or above quality.
- Artists may submit up to six (6) images.
- Submit images for consideration via our event website no later than **June 1, 2008** through <http://www.ey2008.org/submit>
- All images must include:
 - Name of artist
 - Age of artist
 - Title of piece
 - Medium
 - File name in the following format: artistname_title.jpg or .png or .gif
