

BANKING GUIDELINES

-- NEW MONEY POLICY FOR KIDS CAMP--

HARTLAND AND PINECREST

In order to protect the camper's money that they have brought to camp, the following guidelines have been established.

1. HOW TO SEND MONEY TO CAMP: --Each item is a SEPARATE ENVELOPE

Write the **student's name and church** on the front of each envelope.

FOR ALL CAMPS... Separate all money into envelopes for the following:

1. **Photo** -- \$9.00, this is optional, it is a large group photo featuring all campers.
EXACT CASH or CHECK PAYABLE TO SCDC.
2. **Missionary Offering** – a special offering that will be taken for our camp missionary family.
EXACT CASH or CHECK PAYABLE TO SCDC (do not include with the photo money check)
This money goes to help support the missionary's ministry and is a great opportunity for your student to bless them.
3. **General spending money**— (amount of your choice up to a maximum of \$10). CASH ONLY
1 envelope not to exceed \$10.00 for general spending at the snack bar or gift shop.
The general spending money (up to \$10.00) will be held by the camper and will be used during the week for general spending by the student as he/she sees fit.
4. **End of camp money** for snack bar / gift shop —(amount of your choice.) CASH ONLY
1 envelope-- this money will remain sealed and in our secured bank until the end of camp and then will be returned to the camper. Once the envelopes have been turned in on Monday, they will not be opened until they are returned at the end of camp, even if the camper loses or spends the general spending money.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION **PINECREST ONLY.**

5. Horseback riding is an optional activity for campers.
Cost is \$7.00 per person. EXACT CASH ONLY
Camper must have a signed permission slip that has been provided to your church.
6. Skate Board Park is an optional activity for campers.
Cost is \$5.00 per person. EXACT CASH ONLY
Camper must have a signed permission slip that has been provided to your church.

No money should be left in the room unattended.
