In February, 2006 our congregation called eight members to serve on a Pastor Search Committee to seek the Lord's will regarding a Senior Pastor. The church has prayed earnestly that God would reveal His will to us in this matter.

The Pastor Search Committee is pleased to announce that we believe our prayers have been answered. With the wholehearted support of the entire committee, we have extended an invitation to Nate Magloughlin of Chester, South Carolina to preach in view of a call to serve as Senior Pastor of Trinity Baptist Church.

On Sunday, August 5, 2007, Nate will preach in both morning services. That evening we will have a congregational meeting for the purpose of voting to extend a call to Nate Magloughlin for the position of Senior Pastor.
