This begins November 29--December 6. The Week of Prayer and Lottie Moon Offering will continue through December. This year we will be focusing on North Africa.

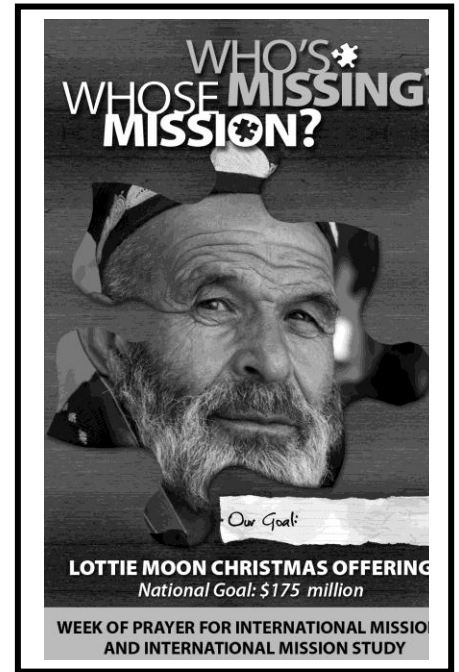
