SANCTUARY CARE

Responsibilities and Check List:

1. Have the sanctuary prepared for worship prior to the Sunday you have been assigned. If you have a conflict with the date you have been assigned please change with another team on the list. In the event of a funeral or wedding, you will be asked to fulfill your duties prior to this service.
2. Two supply boxes are kept in the Narthex closet which is located across from the steps that lead to the choir loft. Extra supplies are kept in this same closet.
3. Place Bibles and Hymnals correctly making sure that each long middle pew has 6 Bibles and 6 Hymnals and each side pew has 2 of each. (See diagram on the supply box lid.)
4. Check Friendship Books for pen and pads.
5. Stained Glass Window booklets should be available in each pew.
6. Each pew should have sharpened pencils, eraser at the top. (Pencil sharpener may be plugged into any convenient outlet.)
7. Each pew pocket should have the following information from front to back: Prayer Request, Meal Reservation, Welcome and Stephen Ministry.
8. Call Sanctuary Guild chairperson if more supplies need to be ordered.
9. Call and remind the next team on the list.

2009 LITURGICAL AND GREENERY CALENDAR

The traditional liturgical colors of the church season are white, purple, red and green. White stands for purity and the festivals of Jesus Christ, primarily Christmas, Easter and All Saints Day. Purple represents repentance, royalty and suffering and is used during Lent and Advent. Red symbolizes the fire of the Holy Spirit and is used during Pentecost and Passion. Green is used for the days which have no special season and signifies growth.
