

Mom's Morning Off

Please read carefully.

Lil' Imprints Nursery is a non-profit, child care facility of St. John's Lutheran Church. The Mom's Morning Off program is a fundraiser for the Early Childhood Ministry. All fees go towards providing the young children of St. John's a safe and nurturing environment. Thank you for your contribution.

Ⓢ **Enrollment** - Mom's Morning Off is a program designed to give moms (or dads) a little time to themselves. Availability of the program is on a first come, first served basis* starting on the registration day of each session. Space is very limited and fills up quickly. Registration forms must be turned in to the nursery staff to reserve your space, no verbal requests will be honored. Previous enrollment in the program does not guarantee a space for your child in future sessions. Only registered children may attend. **No substitutions are allowed without approval.**

Ⓢ **Pick Up** - The program runs from 8:00 AM to 12:00 noon. Children may not be dropped off early and must be picked up by noon. A late fee of \$15.00 will be charged if your child is picked up after 12:10. This fee must be paid prior to the following week to continue with the program. There are no exceptions. Excessive late pickups will result in loss of future program availability.

Ⓢ **Cost/Payment** - The program fee is based on the session length, usually 10-12 weeks, payable by the first day of the session. Payments of cash or check (made out to St. John's) are accepted. Payments not made on the first day of the session will incur a \$10.00 late fee.

Ⓢ **Absences - Absences will not be refunded or credited.** Due to staffing requirements and nature of the program as described above, program fees are not refundable if your child is absent for any reason. However, we do appreciate advance notification of your child's absence so that we may give a child on the waiting list the opportunity to attend for the day.

Ⓢ **Holidays** – This program follows the same holiday/day off schedule as St. John's Lutheran School. There is no session on these days and they are not included in the session fee.

Ⓢ **Sickness** -. For the safety of all the children, please keep sick children at home. Children who have had a fever or cough within 24 hours prior or who have a rash or any colored discharge from the nose will not be permitted to stay. **If any of these symptoms appear during the program time, you will be called and asked to pick up your child.**

Ⓢ **Belongings** - Please bring all of your child's necessary supplies. These include disposable diapers (no cloth diapers, please), bottles, extra clothing, pacifiers, security blankets, etc. **Everything must be labeled.** All children in diapers will be changed at least once or as needed throughout the morning. Please do not allow your child to bring any toys or candy from home.

Ⓢ **Snacks** – We will provide a nutritional snack for your child mid-morning (see schedule). Please inform a staff member immediately if your child has any food allergies. Due to toddler tendencies to “share” food, we can no longer serve individual snacks from home. **Please bring enough drinks/cups for the entire morning.**
