As a camp, we will...

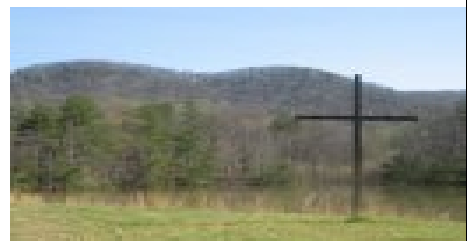
- Continue to provide the children, youth, and adults of Transylvania Presbytery with a safe and nurturing environment to glorify God in the midst of creation.
