Speaking of which-when we come together on **April 24 for our Spring Gathering at the First Presbyterian Church in Richmond**, we will be blessed to have as our guest, **Rev. Tracy Keenan**. This very talented and vivacious woman led us in music in the plenary sessions at the Churchwide Gathering last July. ## CHANGING TIMES FOR HORIZONS MAGAZINE!

Beginning January 1, 2010, *Horizons* magazine and Bible Study has been forced to increase its prices for the first time in a decade. A one-year subscription to the magazine has increased to \$24.95 (from \$18.00); two years to \$44 (from \$32) and three years to \$63 (from \$45). The regular print Bible Study book will increase to \$8 each (from \$6). A copy of the Bible Study book continues to be included with a subscription to *Horizons* magazine. Bulk rates will still be available (two to four subscriptions to one address). *Horizons* now accepts advertising as a way to boost revenue and give readers the opportunity to learn of services or products of interest. An ecumenical Bible Study is now available for non-PCUSA readers.

As you probably know, times are difficult for publishers of newspapers and periodicals. That *Horizons* has a consistent readership speaks volumes about the value of the publication and the loyalty of Presbyterian women. This fairly small price increase and the continuing loyalty of *Horizons'* readers (plus a modest increase in new readership), will keep *Horizons* on the horizon.

## 2010 – 2011 HORIZONS BIBLE STUDY

Though you may not have reached the half-way mark in the current Bible Study on *Joshua*, it is not too soon to think about the new Bible Study, which will be available for delivery in March. Barbara Rossing is the author of the 2010-2011 study, entitled "JOURNEYS THROUGH REVELATION: APOCALYPTIC HOPE FOR TODAY." Barbara Rossing is a professor of New Testament at the Lutheran School of Chicago. She is a fervent environmentalist, as those of us who heard her at the Churchwide Gathering are aware. She will share a hope-filled vision of the book of Revelation which will speak to us and guide our choices as we find ourselves in the midst of the urgent crises of our day.
