

THE PRESBYTERY OF TRANSYLVANIA
STATED MEETING -- DECEMBER 4-5, 2009
Lexington Hilton Hotel and Conference Center (December 4, 2009)
Chapel Hill Presbyterian Church December 5, 2009)
Lexington, Kentucky

The Stated meeting of the Presbytery was convened with prayer by Moderator George Moore at 6:30 p.m. in the Lexington Downtown Hilton Hotel. Dinner was served. Following dinner The Rev. Byron Wade, Vice-Moderator of the Presbyterian Church (USA) addressed the Presbytery and shared from his experiences during the time of his service as Vice-Moderator. Following Mr. Wade's address a time of questions from members of the Presbytery was enjoyed.

At 9:00 pm., it was **moved, seconded, and carried** to recess until 9:00 a.m., at the Chapel Hill Presbyterian Church. The evening was concluded with prayer.

1 The Presbytery reconvened at 9:15 a.m. (A fifteen minute delay was necessitated by inclement weather and slick roads!) The meeting was called to order by the Moderator, George Moore and opened with prayer.

The roll for this meeting was formed. (Appendix A)

1-a Worship was led by Coordinating Council Chair Susan Warren and The Rev. Byron Wade preached. On behalf of the Presbytery General Presbyter Richard Smith presented Mr. Wade with a blue "Kentucky" sweatshirt, assuring Mr. Wade who is employed in North Carolina that wearing the shirt would see him safely through the airport to return to his home. (This assurance was made necessary by virtue of a pending North Carolina-Kentucky basketball game later this day.) Mr. Wade expressed his appreciation for the gift and assured the presbytery he would wear it – at least through the airport!

1-b Following worship the Moderator on the advice of the Stated Clerk declared a quorum present.

1-c The Stated Clerk presented the proposed Docket for the meeting and it was **on motion, with second, adopted** as the Docket for this meeting..(Appendix B)

1-d The Moderator appointed The Rev. Woody Berry and The Rev. Barrett Milner to serve as the Resolutions Committee.

1-e The Rev. Geary Scott, Designated Pastor of Chapel Hill Church welcomed the presbytery and introduced Ed Florrieck, who shared a brief history of the church.

1-f At the request of the Moderator members present introduced "first time" Elder commissioners to the meeting. Those introduced were warmly received.

1-g Guests and corresponding members were introduced. The Rev. Helen Locklear, member of Coastal Carolina Presbytery was on motion enrolled as a corresponding member of the Presbytery.

2 The Consent Agenda was presented by the Stated Clerk as follows:

The commission of The Presbytery of Transylvania to install Douglas M. Beltzner as Pastor at First Presbyterian Church, Winchester, Kentucky, met at 3:30 p.m. on Sunday, October 11, 2009, at the Church.

The meeting was convened with prayer by Rev. Steiner. The chairperson of the commission, Rev. Steiner, declared that a quorum was present and appointed Rev. Jack Wilhelm to serve as secretary. The order and content of the service were reviewed and approved, being in keeping with the Constitution of the Presbyterian Church (USA). The minutes were read and approved. The Commission moved to the sanctuary for the service upon an approved motion that its meeting would be adjourned with the pronouncement of the benediction at the close of the service by Rev. Beltzner.

On motion the report was seconded and adopted.

3-a The minutes of the September 8, 2009 stated meeting and the September 22, 2009 Called meeting were presented and on motion adopted as printed.

3-b The report of the Stated Clerk was presented. (Appendix C) The report noted Stated Meeting Dates for the presbytery for the year 2010. The Stated Clerk **moved that the annual report defining the Representation Report of the presbytery.** (Appendix C) **Motion seconded, and carried.**

4. The report of the Coordinating Council was presented by the Council's Moderator, The Rev. Susan Warren. On behalf of the Council, Mrs. Warren nominated members of the Nominating Committee for 2010-2012. (Appendix D) Moderator Moore

asked if there were additional nominations from the floor and there being none, declared those nominated elected.

- 5 The report of the General Presbyter was presented and received.
- 6 The Rev. Helen Locklear, Board of Pensions representative spoke to the Presbytery addressing the concerns of members of the Pension Plan.
- 7 The Rev. Mike Ward, delegate to the Kentucky Council of Churches reported on the recent meeting of the Council (Appendix E)
- 8 Elder Catesby Woodford, Treasurer, presented the report of the Treasurer. (Appendix F)
- 9 The report of the Administration and Finance Committee was presented by The Rev. Jim Stewart, Chairman. (Appendix G) Four recommendations were presented by the committee:

- a. **That the 2010 Operating Budget of \$563,587 (pages 2-3) and the Burnamwood Subsidiary Budget of \$253,280 (page 4) be adopted.**

- b. **The distribution of Unified Mission Giving for 2010 be as follows:**

- c. **The Presbytery per capita assessment remain at \$23.50 per member.**

- d. The Administration & Finance Committee recommended to the presbytery at the June 2009 meeting the continuation of our lease at 2480 Fortune Drive with the following terms: 5-year lease contract beginning in August 2009 at the current rate of \$2,835 per month. This was approved by presbytery. The actual agreement with the landlord is a 5-year lease contract beginning in August 2009 at the current rate of \$2,835 per month with a review and possible adjustment after the 2nd year. Recommend that this be approved.

On motion these recommendations were approved. Chairman Stewart directed the presbytery's attention to the annual audit in Appendix G which was received.

- 10 The report for the operation of Camp Burnamwood was presented by The Rev. Pete Jones, director. The report was received.
- 11 The report of the Nominating Committee was presented by Elder Bill Owen, who placed those named in nomination. (Appendix H) Moderator Moore asked for additional nominations from the floor and there being none, declared those nominated elected.

- 12 The report of the Committee on Ministry was presented by The Rev. Melissa Sevier, Chair. (Appendix I) Actions of the Committee were reported. The following seven (7) recommendations of the committee were presented:
1. Recommend Clem Street as Moderator of Session of First Presbyterian Church of Pikeville.
 2. Recommend Bill Vanzant as Moderator of Sessions of Peter Creek and Shepard Memorial.
 3. Recommend Lyn Eberly as Moderator of Session of Sharon Presbyterian Church and be authorized to administer the sacraments there.
 4. Recommend Fred Hood as Moderator of Session of the First Presbyterian Church, Flemingsburg.
 5. Recommend that an Administrative Commission be appointed to proceed toward the closing of the Ebenezer Presbyterian Church and that the following people be named to the commission:

 2. Rev. Betsy Steiner, Retired
 3. Rev. Rene' Whitaker, Maysville
 4. Ted Kuster, Paris
 5. Bob Garvin, Carlisle

 6. That the presbytery elect the following commission to ordain Daniel Phelps on behalf of and at the request of Sierra Blanca Presbytery: Ministers Kathy Riley, Beth Garrod-Logsdon and elders Billie Haws, Pat Harney, Larry Synder and Ken Simpson. The Rev. Katherine Redmond, Member of Mid-Kentucky Presbytery, be invited to participate as a corresponding member. The date for the ordination is Sunday, December 13, 2009 at 3:00 pm in the Wilmore Presbyterian Church. (Mr. Phelps has been examined satisfactorily by Sierra Blanca Presbytery on November 21st and a call has been extended by First Presbyterian Church, Artesia pending ordination by Transylvania.)

On motion the recommendations were approved.

As part of its report, the Committee on Ministry recognized ministers who have served twenty-five and fifty years since their Ordination. Those recognized were: The Rev. Bill McAtee, The Rev. Bill Vanzant, The Rev. Jack Wilhelm, The Rev. Gene Thompson and The Rev. Ruth Fiscella. The Rev. Bill McAtee, retired General Presbyter presented a statistical summary he had prepared concerning these and others who have served in this Presbytery. It was moved, seconded and carried to spread a copy of this report on the minutes of the meeting. The report is as follows:

Class of '59 and '60 Cohorts
478 YEARS OF SERVICE/MEMBERSHIP IN TRANSY !!!!!

The Class of '59 was made up of those who entered Louisville Presbyterian Seminary in the fall of 1956 and graduated in the spring of 1959; a few graduated in 1960. An unusual number of members of the Class of '59 [15 of 48 or 31%] and cohorts* in the Class of '60 were ordained and/or served at one time or another in the Presbytery of Transylvania or one of its predecessor presbyteries. The present Presbytery of Transylvania PC(USA) covers basically that same geographical area of the Presbytery of Transylvania (Union) that was formed in 1971. This boundary configuration is the longest running [almost 39 years] un-realigned configuration of any presbytery [an estimated forty plus presbyteries and/or portions of presbyteries] that has existed in this same geographic area since the founding of the original Transylvania Presbytery in 1786.

Following the report of the Committee the Stated Clerk noted that the new Standing Rules of the Presbytery which become effective January 1, 2010, require that the Moderator or his/her designee be named as a member of Commissions to ordain and/or Install ministers. Howard Moffett, be included in those commissions previously approved by the Presbytery and that the inclusion of the Moderator in future commissions will remain in effect until further action is taken by the Presbytery. **Motion approved.**

- 13 The report of the Committee on Preparation for Ministry was presented by The Rev. Kathy Riley, member of the committee. (Appendix J) Actions of the committee were reported. The committee moved that Inquirer Wanda Olive be received as a Candidate for ordination of Word and Sacrament. Motion carried. Moderator Moore asked the appropriate questions and they being answered in the affirmative declared Mrs. Olive a Candidate for Ordination. The presbytery joined in expressing appreciation and encouragement.
- 14 The report of the Youth Committee was presented by The Rev. Scott Cervas and was received.
- 15 The following report of the Resolutions Committee was presented by The Rev. Woody Berry and was on motion adopted:

General Presbyter Richard Smith expressed the Presbytery's appreciation to retiring moderator George Moore and on behalf of the Presbytery presented him with a gavel as a token of the office he has held. The Presbytery rose as a body to applaud and express their appreciation to Mr. Moore.

The Stated Clerk, noting the completion of the adopted Docket moved that the Presbytery stand adjourned following the benediction until the next Stated Meeting, to be held Tuesday, March 9, 2010 @ 10:00 a.m., Beaumont Presbyterian Church, Lexington, Kentucky.

The meeting was closed with prayer and the benediction offered by The Rev. Howard Moffett.
