We also will visit “Norma’s Nest,” a bunk-house available to you to house your mission or youth work groups who wish to work on housing sites. “Norma’s Nest” is owned by the Low Income Housing Coalition of Eastern Kentucky (LINKS), which leads work groups of any/no skill levels. LINKS Executive Director Eddie Patton will lead our mission trip and discuss area low-income housing issues. **Meet in the lobby of Jenny Wiley State Park Lodge.**
- † **Friday, June 6 @ 5:30 p.m.—Dinner at Jenny Wiley State Park May Lodge, Followed by Sunset Boat Ride on Dewey Lake.** Back by popular demand! **Directions to the Church and Jenny Wiley State Park**

From Lexington and nearby points west: Take I-64 E / I-75 S toward Ashland. Keep left on **I-64 E toward Winchester/Ashland**. Exit onto **Bert T. Combs Mountain Pkwy E** via Exit 98 toward **Campton / Prestonsburg**. Drive about 75 miles. Bert T. Combs Mountain Pkwy becomes **E. Mountain Pkwy**, then becomes **KY-114 E**. Drive about 18 miles. Then ...

- **To Continue to Jenny Wiley State Park:** US 23 South toward Pikeville. Take the Martin/Hazard exit. At the top of the ramp, turn left. Drive about 3 miles and look for the signs to Jenny Wiley State Park.
- **To Continue to First Presbyterian Church:** Turn **right onto North Lake Drive / KY 1428**. Look on your right for the Dairy Cheer Restaurant and the Jerry’s Restaurant Signs. The church is located on your right, between the two restaurants.
