TYM Time Talent & Treasure Contributions

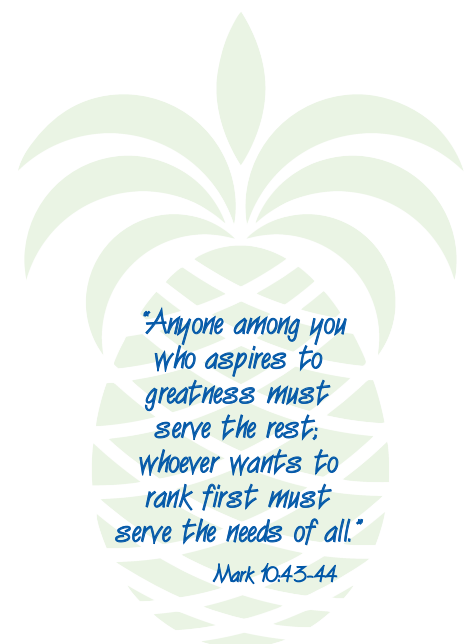
The TYM youth served as altar attendants, greeters, Christmas music ministers, as part of confirmation preparation, and accompanied Eucharistic ministers to the sick and homebound during a weekend visit. TYM youth also bought, wrapped and delivered Christmas gifts for a mom and three children. These youth picked approximately 175 pounds of blueberries for local food assistance programs, bagged sweet potatoes at the NC Food Bank, and packaged rice-based meals for hungry people in Third World countries as part of the Rotary Club's Million Meal Service Project. Through admission to various TYM activities, the youth also collected 151 canned goods for our parish food pantry. TYM youth helped serve dinner at the Urban Ministries Kitchen, participated in the annual CROP walk, cleared wood from the American Tobacco Trail, washed and painted windows in the Duke Hospital Children's ward, and prepared lunch and entertained children at the AGAPE Corner School. During Lent TYM youth presented "Shadow Box" Stations of the Cross and an evening soup meal for the parish. This past summer TYM youth assisted with Vacation Bible Camp and 11 youth took part in a week of service to the poor and needy in Lancaster, Pennsylvania as part of Catholic HEART Work Camp. The TYM youth are an active and vibrant part of our parish community and their contributions are greatly appreciated.
