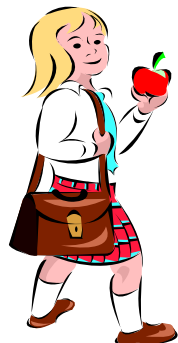

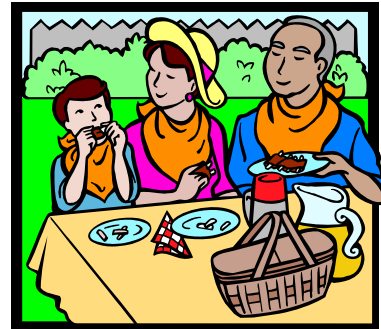

Steve Wray, The STM DJ, will be coming to play music and supervise organized games.



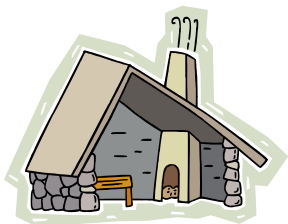
The Spring Fling is sponsored by HSA and gives us one last chance to be together with our School families for fun, food, and fellowship before summer break.
