On April 6, at the 9:15 Mass at St. Thomas More, three of my children and I were received into the full communion of the Catholic Church. This very moving Mass culminated our past year's participation in the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults and Children, inquiry sessions for those interested in learning about the Catholic faith. For my children, their faith journey grew from and was enriched by their experiences as students at STM. For me, my journey had its roots as a baptized Christian and my participation in the Catholic community for the past eight years as a parent of the school. It became clear to me a year ago that my many relationships with others at the school and church over the years, my volunteer work, my conversations about prayer and fellowship with friends, were all pointing me toward this journey of joining the Catholic faith. I told others many times in my RCIA class that my children's faith, the way they so earnestly expressed it and so seriously practiced it, was a true inspiration to me. We are all as parents

giving our children the gift of a Catholic education. I recognized that my children's faith was at the core of who they are and how they see the world. This is something that they will carry with them forever and I wanted to be able to share and grow in that faith with them. To have been able to take this journey with my children was truly a gift.
