2007-2008 Supply Lists

Parents please note:

All students Pre-K through 8th grade must have a sturdy book bag. No wheels will be permitted unless under a doctor's order, in which case written documentation must be provided.

Art Supplies (Pre-K through 5th grade)

All children in grades **Pre-K through 5th** are required to have the items listed below to be used in **Art class**.

**Parents, please check supplies that are brought home in May.
Only buy new if needed.**

(These items are separate from the classroom items needed)

2 black Sharpie markers
2 drawing pencils
2 erasers
Pair of scissors (Fiskars or similar)
Watercolors (preferably Prang or Crayola – **NO** RoseArt or semimoist)
Crayons (24 or more)
Colored markers (regular and thin)
Elmer's glue (School glue or glue-all)
Colored pencils

Pre-Kindergarten

1 sturdy backpack (large zipper compartment with ample space)
(Approximately 18" in length and 14" wide for lunchbox and take home items)
1 lunchbox with 4-6 oz plastic cup that will come home each day
1 roll 35 mm film (Kodak – 24 or 26, 200 speed-all purpose please)
3 container baby wipes (at least 80 count; refills are fine)
2 large rolls of paper towels
1 bottle antibacterial spray cleaner (Fantastic or Lysol)
1 container of hand sanitizer
1 2" side roll of masking tape (3M or Scotch preferably)

In addition, each Pre-K child is requested to pay **\$25.00** to cover the cost of daily classroom supplies.

Please note that art supplies needed are listed separately.

Kindergarten

- 1 sturdy backpack
- 1 two-pocket folder (for mail to go home)
- 1 lunchbox
- 1 can of juice (46 fl. oz.) **per month** (real juice, e.g. Juicy Juice)

Please do not purchase any additional supplies than listed above.

In addition, each child is requested to pay **\$40.00** at the Open House in August to cover the cost of daily classroom supplies and rest mat which the classroom teacher has already purchased. Your \$40.00 enables the teachers to purchase supplies in bulk and have them all the same.

Please make all checks payable to St. Thomas More School with “Kindergarten supplies” written in the memo line.

Each child must provide his/her own healthy snack each day.

Please note that art supplies needed are listed separately.

First Grade

In addition, each child is requested to pay **\$40.00** at the Open House in August to be used by the teachers to purchase children’s individual supplies (pencils, crayons, glue, scissors, Weekly Reader, etc.)

Please make all checks payable to St. Thomas More School with “first grade supplies” written in the memo line.

- Sturdy backpack
- Regular size lunch box
- Large box of tissues
- Large container anti-bacterial wipes (75 count)

Each child must provide his/her own healthy snack each day.

Please note that art supplies needed are listed separately.

Second Grade

Each child will need a backpack without wheels and a lunch box.

Second grade teachers will purchase supplies for each student. Teachers will collect a **\$50.00** fee at the Open House in August to cover the cost of supplies (pencils, folders, markers, crayons, pencil boxes, National Geographic Magazines, journals, Kleenex, cleaning supplies, and **two field trips locally**, etc.)

Please make all checks payable to St. Thomas More School with “second grade supplies” written in the memo line.

A wish list for the teacher and classroom supplies will be available at the Open House.

Please note that art supplies needed are listed separately.

Third Grade

Three 70 page 8 ½" x 11" wide ruled spiral notebooks

(All different solid-colored covers)

1 pocket folder (Durable heavy Plastic)

(NO TRAPPER KEEPERS OR BINDERS)

One 12 inch ruler **with centimeter and inch markings**

5 dozen # 2 pencils (**Sharpened** – no mechanical pencils)

only these kinds of pencils please (Ticonderoga #2 soft **or** Mirado Black Warrior # 2)

One ½" binder (for Library Science)

One 1" green three ring binder (Music)

1 package eraser caps

1 supply box

1 pair scissors

1 glue stick

1 small bottle Elmer's glue

One 24 pack Crayons

2 black sharpie markers – fine point and extra fine point

1 large box tissues

1 roll paper towels

2 containers of Lysol Sanitizing Wipes

2 packs loose leaf paper (150 sheets) **WIDE RULED**

When school starts, each student must purchase a homework assignment book. Send in check for \$4.00 written to **St. Thomas More** School with "assignment book" written in memo line.

This is only a generic third grade supply list. Several items are likely to be needed by each individual teacher when school begins in August.

Be prepared to cover 4 textbooks with book soxs and workbooks with clear contact paper.

Please note that art supplies needed are listed separately.

Fourth Grade

Six 1" 3 ring binders (1 white, 1 black, 2 blue, 1 green and 1 red)

2 packages 8 tab three-ring dividers with pockets (plastic preferred)

3 notebook paper packs

6 dozen #2 pencils, sharpened (No mechanical pencils)

4 red pens

One 12 inch ruler (inches, cm, and mm markings)

3 flexible pencil cases with 3 holes punched (to fit inside 3 ring binders)

1 pack of lined white 3" x 5" index cards (for Library Science)

5 book covers for hardback books (book soxs preferred)

4 glue sticks

Scissors

2 individual small pencil sharpeners

Erasers

1 pack hole reinforcements

1 roll of paper towels

1 box tissues

1 bottle 409 cleaner

Please label all school supplies and clothes with a black permanent marker. Bring all supplies on the first day of school.

Fifth Grade

Reading and Language Arts

- 1 zippered pencil case
- 1 marble composition book
- One 1 ½" three ring binder (red) with dividers
- One pocket folder (red)
- 2 pink "Pearl" erasers

Social Studies and Religion

- 1 purple folder with pockets and tabs

Science

- One 1" green three ring binder with dividers

Math

- 1 large 200 sheet spiral - blue

Library/Research Science

- One ½" three ring binder (last year's is fine)
- 1 package of 3: x 5" white lined index cards

Spanish

- 1 yellow pocket folder

Music

- One 1" black three ring binder

Classroom supplies (To be given to homeroom teacher)

- 1 large package of #2 pencils
- 1 package pencil cap erasers
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 large box of soft tissues

NO "trapper keeper" type binders please!

Note: All supplies and clothing should be clearly marked with a black permanent marker (first and last name). Please do not bring pens to class. Only work written in pencil (or typed on the computer) will be accepted.

Textbooks will need to be covered with book jackets or book "soxs".

When school starts, each student must purchase a Homework Assignment Book. Send in check for \$4.00 written to **St. Thomas More School** with "assignment book" written in the memo line.

Returning students should wash their art bag from last year. New students should bring their art supplies in a strong Ziploc bag.

Please note that art supplies needed are listed separately.

Art Supplies

Students in grades 6, 7, 8 will not be required to buy their own art supplies. There is a **mandatory art supply fee of \$20.00 per student** which Mrs. Ives will use to purchase supplies in bulk. Please give this fee to the homeroom teacher. The money should be in an envelope marked "art supply fee" with your **child's name and grade** clearly marked.

All checks should be written to St. Thomas More School with "art fee" written in the memo line.

All Upper School Students

When school starts, students in **grades 6, 7, and 8** must purchase a homework assignment book. There is fee of \$4.00 per student for these books. All checks should be written out to **St. Thomas More School** with "assignment book" written in the memo line.
