TABLE-To-Go is our newest food delivery program for hungry Chapel Hill & Carrboro children. Like the ongoing Weekend Meal Backpack Program, *this new program puts food directly into the hands of local elementary school age youngsters at risk for hunger.* TABLE-To-Go offers family meal-sized portions of nutritious food to children through low-income after-schools and community groups.
