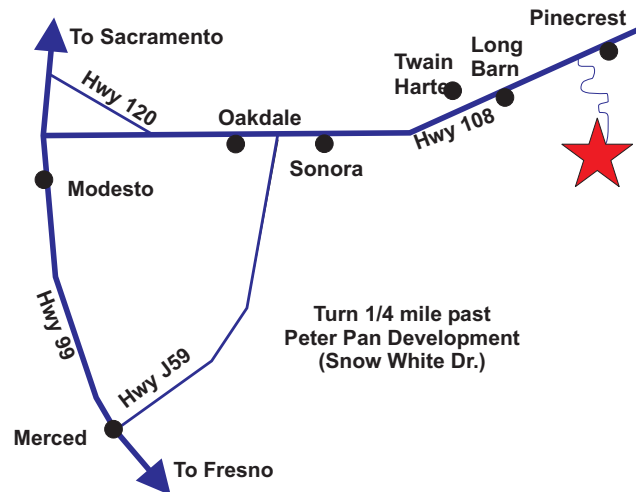

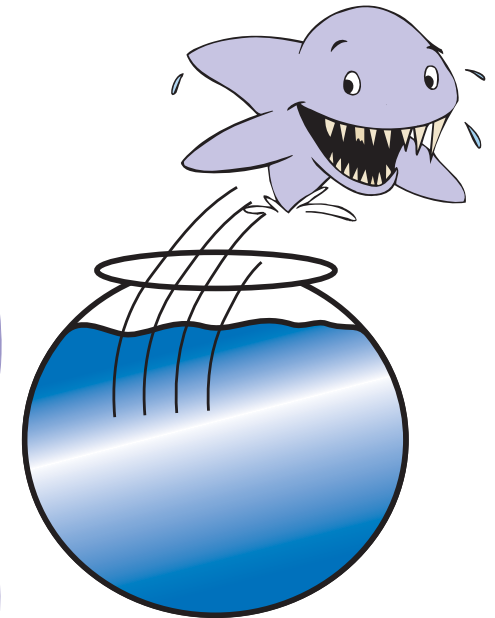

Who:? Anyone who is in the 7th - 12th grade and has a parent in vocational Christian ministry.

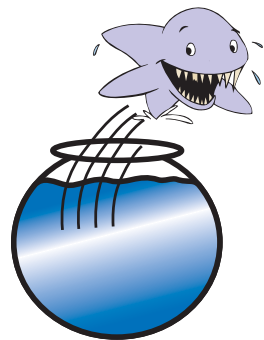
What:? 3 days, 2 nights of worship, small groups, spiritual growth, and fun in the mountains near Sonora

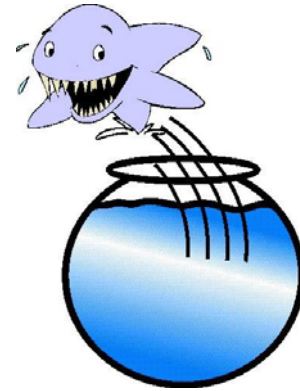

Program:
Registration starts at 4 p.m. on Friday, April 25. Dinner will be served at 5:30.
The program will end with lunch at 12:30 p.m. on Sunday, April 27.
The program includes evening worship times with small groups and devotions in the morning. The afternoon is reserved for recreation and relationship building with the staff and other PKs.

FAQ

Why does it cost so much?

First, no one will be turned away for financial reasons. The Healthy Church Group will work with families to arrange payment options. The \$190 fee is the actual cost the Healthy Church Group pays for each camper. While there is no “scholarship” money, there are generous discount available for students whose churches support the work of California Southern Baptist Convention through the Cooperative Program and the California Mission Offering. Who can attend the retreat?

The retreat is open to any student in the 7th – 12th grade who has a parent in vocational ministry. This includes children of senior pastors or any other ministerial staff, either full or part time. The retreat is also open to children of denominational workers. but does not include children of deacons, office staff, custodians, or volunteers.

Why does the retreat extend to a Sunday?

Sunday retreats always present a difficulty for families in ministry and the Healthy Church Group generally avoids programming events over a Sunday. Because many PKs find Sundays to be a work day (running PowerPoint, working in the nursery, or just having the feeling of being watched by everyone), the PK Retreat seeks to provide a change of pace on Sunday morning. Students will find it to be a true day of rest with a worship service designed with them in mind.

How do we handle transportation?

Transportation to the event will be the responsibility of each family. CSBC cannot provide transportation to and from the event, but Student and Family Ministries will work with families to coordinate transportation wherever possible.

Here are three suggestions for transportation:

1. Carpool with other churches in the area or association.
2. Allow a staff member or church volunteer to drive students to and from the retreat.
3. Take the weekend as a vacation for the family. Send the 7th -12th grade students to the retreat, ask a church family to take any younger children, and spend the weekend as a couple's retreat in nearby Sonora. What does the fish logo mean?

You know that living in a ministerial family can be like living in a fishbowl. The weekend is a simple opportunity for students to escape the fishbowl for awhile.

What else do I need to know?

Everything else you need will be sent once you have expressed interest in having your student participate. Information will include directions, registration and medical forms, emergency phone numbers, and a "what to bring" list.

2008 PK Retreat Discount Schedule

To determine your church's discount for the retreat:

1. Determine the amount your church currently gives to the Cooperative Program (the pastor or church treasurer will have this information). You may use your previous fiscal year or your current year-to-date amount.
2. Determine your church's undesignated income. This does not include money given to a building fund or similar fund or special missions offerings, but does include all other money. Use the same time period as in step 1.
3. Divide the amount from step 1 by the amount in step 2.
4. Find your percentage in column A below. Your cost is in column C on the same row.
5. Determine if you church gave any amount to the California Mission Offering in 2007. If so, find your total cost in column D on the same row.
