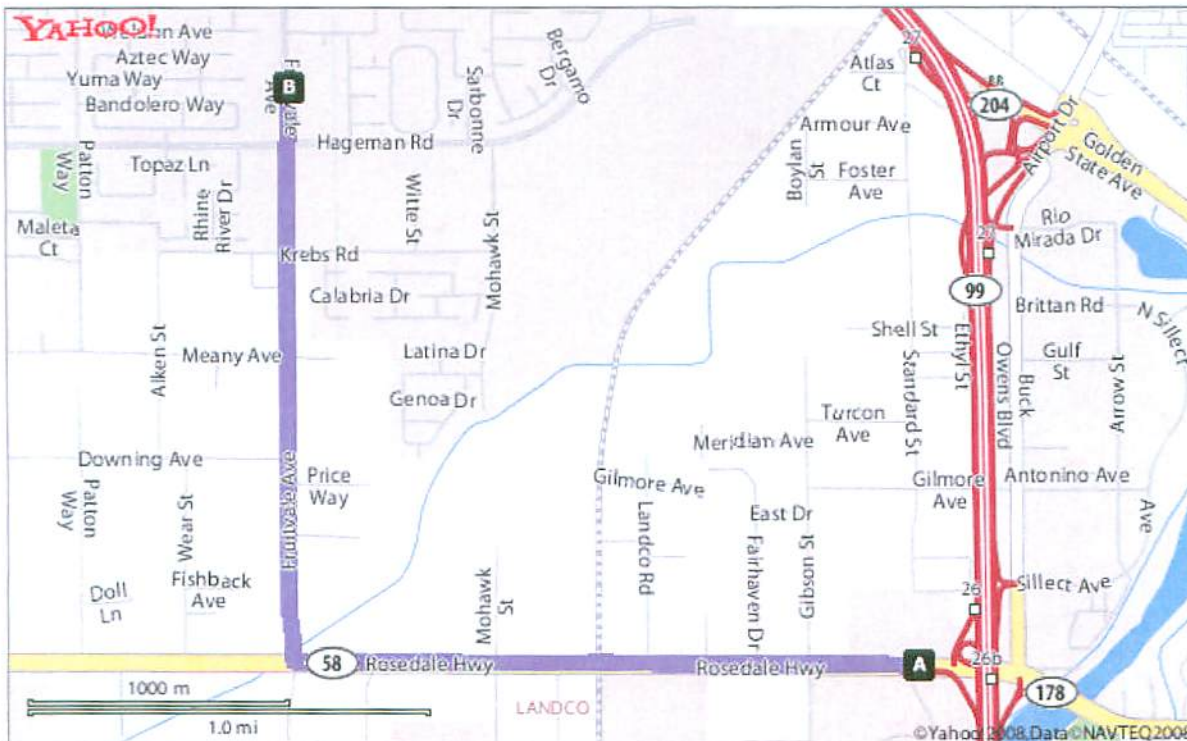

1. Start at **3540 ROSEDALE HWY, BAKERSFIELD** going toward **CAMINO DEL RIO CT** go **1.5 mi**
2. Turn **R** on **FRUITVALE AVE** go **1.4 mi**
3. Arrive at **4800 FRUITVALE AVE, BAKERSFIELD**, on the **R** go **< 0.1 mi**
