

Built for Others Ministry Commitment

What is Built for Others?:

Built for others is a ministry team of students that comes together for the purpose of learning how to best use their gifts and abilities to serve within and outside of the church. We use the ministry programming of TREK as our opportunity to learn and begin to experiment with using our gifts and talents.

What is the time commitment?:

Students who commit to being a part of the Built for Others ministry team need to regularly attend on Sunday mornings, Sunday evening Community groups (once a month on Sunday evenings), training meetings (once a month on Sunday mornings at 8 am) and events (this doesn't mean that you can never miss however since this is one of our main areas of ministry it would be important to be there). If for some reason you will be unable to attend, it is your responsibility to communicate that to your adult leaders so that they can plan accordingly.

I recognize that this is a big time commitment and the some simple have conflicts that make this impossible. If you are interested but simply cannot make the time commitment right now, feel free to join up when your schedule allows.

What does this commitment require?:

A different approach. You would come on Sunday mornings (or events, retreats or whatever) with a mindset to reach out and not merely take in (I actually believe that the students involved at this level will find that they receive more as they give). It means learning you use how God has uniquely shaped you as a person in order to minister both in and outside of the church. Additionally, being a part of Built for Others requires flexibility. With our purpose and ministry strategy in TREK, I will need this group to go where I need them rather than choosing what group they want to be in on Sunday mornings.

When do we meet?:

Built for Others ministry team will meet one Sunday a month in the morning at 8:00 am in the chapel at East. We will be able to go to church then and follow that up with TREK Sunday Morning Live. I know that this will make for some long mornings but it is when most are available and it does not eat into other nights of the week.

We will use this time for equipping, planning, evaluating and praying together. These are a vital part of what we are doing, so it is a necessity to be a part.
