DEFINITION

A Desiring God Team Teacher is one who shares weekly classroom teaching duties for children who are in one of the grades from 1 to 4 during a Sunday morning worship service.

PURPOSE

TERM OF SERVICE

One Year, Weekly, September 2007 – August 2008

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Pray for fellow team members, students and their families.
2. Complete department fall orientation before serving.
3. Attend any meetings throughout the year scheduled by the Department Coordinator.
4. Work out team schedule to make sure there are always at least two team members in the room on a Sunday. If needed, secure one of the approved substitutes for your department and notify your Coordinator.
5. Arrive 15 minutes before service start time.
6. In the event of an absence, secure an approved substitute and notifies the department coordinator.
7. Serve with your team members in sharing these responsibilities:
 - Warmly greeting and welcoming your students and their parents.
 - Preparing and teaching the curriculum provided on your teaching week.
 - Teaching key verse, help them find the verse in their Bibles and explain its meaning and application.
 - Pray with the children and teach them to pray.
 - Keeps accurate attendance and visitor records in the Record-Keeping book.
 - Complete welcome postcards to first-time visitors
