DEFINITION

A Joyful Noise Leader is one who leads a group of children in their activity time, and shares the teaching of the songs to the entire Joyful Noise Choir.

PURPOSE

TERM OF SERVICE

Sunday Evenings; September 2010 thru March 2011

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Pray for the children and their families.
2. Arrive to the choir room 15 minutes before the start of choir.
3. Supervise the graded choir time:
 - Greet children as the doors are opened to your room.
 - Supervise opening prayer time.
 - Plan, have materials ready and lead an activity from the curriculum.
 - Lead children into large group room at the appropriate time.
4. Share teaching of songs with the other graded choir leader.
5. Determine motions for songs with the other graded choir leader.
6. Be ready to rehearse your song on your assigned night.
7. Share choir leading at the Christmas Program and the Spring Concert.
8. Prepares and leads the children during the Christmas Program and Spring Choir Concert.
9. Notify the Choir Director about absences.
