Jubilation Station Media Assistant

DEFINITION

This role helps lead the children in the music and teaching portions of the Large Group Program. He or she is comfortable in a behind-the-scenes role and able to use the church's media equipment properly.

TERM OF SERVICE

One Year; Weekly, September 2007 – August 2008

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Pray for the staff and children of Jubilation Station.
2. Arrive 30 minutes early to set up sound equipment, meet with Large Group and Drama Leaders in preparation for Large Group Program.
3. Start music for arrival of children.
4. Interact with children during Activity Station time.
5. Work sound and video equipment during Large Group Program
6. Rehearse, as needed, Large Group Program with team members.
7. Meet periodically with Music Leader to review curriculum.
