Preschool Youth Helper

DEFINITION

A youth helper is a 5th through 12th grade student who serves in a preschool classroom during a worship service.

PURPOSE

- To allow youth the opportunity to learn from adult role models who model Christ's love as they serve.
- To model Christ's love through their actions and words and to learn from adults as they care for and teach children.

RELATIONSHIPS

- Recruited by the Director of Preschool Ministries.
- Responsible to the Department Coordinator.

TERM OF SERVICE

One or more Sunday's a month during a school year.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Complete department orientation before serving.
2. Pray for and encourage the children.
3. Arrive at least 10 minutes before the service start time.
4. When unable to be present, notify the Department Coordinator.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Attends First Baptist Church.
2. Completes a Youth Application.
3. Has a love of preschoolers and desires to help them learn about God.
4. Is dependable.
5. To serve in the nursery or toddler rooms, needs to have completed a certified child care class, or provide written documentation of previous experience caring for infants or toddlers (CE office provides form).
