Saturday Night Child Care

DEFINITION

A Saturday Night Child Care Team Member is one who serves in the toddler classroom during the Saturday evening worship service.

PURPOSE

To model Christ's love while caring for the physical and emotional needs of toddlers and teaching them the earliest concept of God's love.

RELATIONSHIPS

- Recruited by the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator.
- Responsible to the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator.

TERM OF SERVICE

A minimum of 2 Saturdays per month from September 2010 - August 2011

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Pray for other team members, toddlers and their families.
2. Complete department orientation before serving.
3. Attend any meetings throughout the year scheduled by the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator.
4. Arrive 15 minutes before service start time.
5. In the event of an absence, notify the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator.
6. Serves with your team members in sharing these responsibilities:
 - Warmly greeting and welcoming toddlers and their parents.
 - Nurturing toddlers according to the Protection and Department Policies and parent instructions.
 - Organizing and sterilizing toys and large equipment, countertops and tables so that the room is ready for the next class.
7. Notify the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator of supplies needed in the classroom.

2. Attend weekly worship.
3. Possess a love for children.
4. Meet the screening requirements
