DEFINITION

A 345 Jumpstart Team Member is one who serves in a 3-K classroom during the Saturday night worship service.

PURPOSE

TERM OF SERVICE

A minimum of 2 Saturdays per month from September 2010 - August 2011.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Pray for fellow team members, children and their families.
2. Complete department orientation before serving.
3. Attend any meetings throughout the year scheduled by the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator.
4. Arrive 15 minutes before service start time.
5. Notify the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator when you need to be absent.
6. Serve with your team members in sharing these responsibilities:
 - Warmly greeting and welcoming the children and their parents.
 - Ensures the provided curriculum is taught as directed by the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator.
 - Organizing and sterilizing toys and large equipment, countertops and tables so that the room is ready for the next class.
7. Notify the Saturday Night Kids' Coordinator of supplies needed in the classroom
