

The "Peace not Walls: Stand for Justice in the Holy Land" campaign of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America

"Peace not Walls: Stand for Justice in the Holy Land" is the name of the campaign established by the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America to carry out the goals of its strategy for engagement in Israel and Palestine. The campaign has a three-pronged approach of **A**wareness through education about the region, the people, and the issues involved; **A**ccompaniment of those working nonviolently for a just peace through prayer and physical presence; and **A**dvocacy through action and financial support. The goals of the strategy are "a viable, contiguous Palestinian state; a secure Israeli state at peace with its Arab neighbors; and a shared Jerusalem with equal access and rights for Jews, Christians, and Muslims" (<http://www.elca.org/Our-Faith-In-Action/Justice/Peace-Not-Walls.aspx>).
