Carpool Safety at the Middle School

As we settle in to our new surroundings the safety of our children continues to be our #1 concern. An area of particular concern is the Middle School-Early Learning Center morning carpool. For your child's safety it is important that they get out of your vehicle on the passenger side so that they are not exposed to the traffic moving through the drive-way. If your child must get out of a drivers side door then please park and do so where it is safe. Along with this is the danger created by getting out of your vehicle to get a child out of a car seat. We ask that drivers do not get out of the vehicle while in the carpool line. If you must get out to remove your child from a car seat please park first and then do so where it is safer for everyone.

By following these simple guidelines we can all make our carpool lines safer for our children.
