Seventh Grade Program

Organizational skills, study skills, and time management are stressed in the seventh grade. Independence and personal responsibility are the goals of instruction and methods. Each student is expected to organize his/her own notebook and to be responsible for recording and completing daily and long-range assignments.

- **READING** - The reading program utilizes an anthology of literature titled, Adventures In Literature; three novels and Vocabulary Workshop.
- **ENGLISH/AP ENGLISH** - The focus of the language arts program is on writing with an emphasis on Language mechanics and vocabulary development using The English Workshop & Shurley Method as the English text. The AP English classes focus on the same material, but at an accelerated pace.
- **PRE-ALGEBRA * AP PRE-ALGEBRA**- All seventh grade students are enrolled in pre-algebra using the Prentice-Hall math series. The AP math students cover the same material but at a faster pace.
- **EARTH SCIENCE** - The study of the changing Earth, its material, and the processes by which these changes occur using the Prentice-Hall Science Explorer-Earth Science series.
- **TEXAS HISTORY** - The sequence of study begins with the earliest known inhabitants and brings the student through the modern period using the Prentice Hall, Texas-The Lonestar State textbook.
- **SPANISH** - Spanish instruction is a core class and meets daily. Students complete a designated portion of a first year Spanish text. Increased conversational, grammar, and writing skills are emphasized.

- **OUTDOOR EDUCATION** - Seventh grade students experience hands-on, outdoor experiences to enhance awareness, understanding and a sense of responsibility toward each other and the environment. Their Outdoor Education trip is taken to Camp Champions outside Marble Falls.
