THE SECRETARY OF THE CONVENTION

The attached schedule shows the number of lay delegates to the Annual Convention apportioned to each parish and mission. The basis of apportionment was changed by a constitutional amendment approved by the 191st Annual Convention. Previously, delegates were apportioned on the basis of the three-year average of adult, *confirmed*, communicants in good standing as reported on a special addendum to the annual parochial report. Beginning with the 192nd Annual Convention, the apportionment is based on the three-year average of the number of communicants in good standing, as reported on line 3 of the parochial report, less the number of those under the age of 16, as reported on line 4. The figures used to compute the apportionment are those published in the Journals of the Convention.

Please note the following changes in delegation size since the last Annual Convention.

These congregations have lost one delegate each:

These congregations have gained one delegate each:

Emmanuel, Warrenton

In most cases these changes are the result of three-year trends and would have occurred notwithstanding the recent change in the basis of apportionment.
