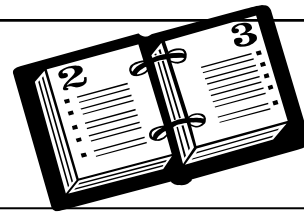

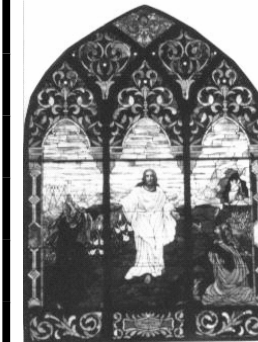

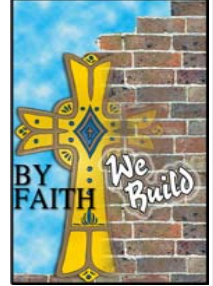
CONNECTING WITH THE CHURCH


"SPRING"ING TOWARDS THE FINISH LINE!
