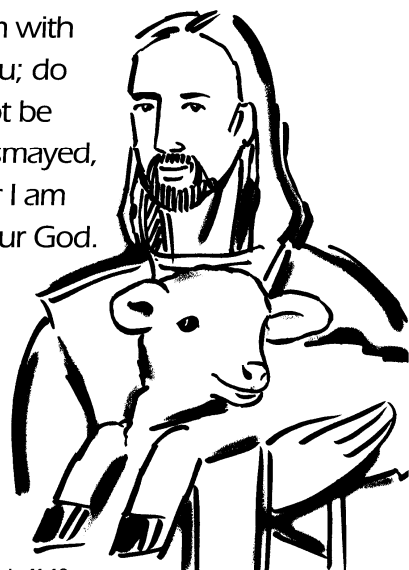

## UNISON PRAYER CONFESSION

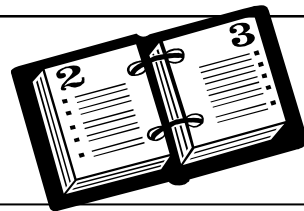

## CONNECTING WITH THE CHURCH

Through prayers and much effort on the part of many, we were able to return last Sunday to worship together in our newly-renovated church sanctuary. We were pleased to have Ralph Alster, architect for the project, join us. Progress continues towards finalizing this huge renovation project. This past week, the construction crew continued to finish up various areas in the Christian Education Building. Please continue to be careful when you are in or around the church building during the week. We are still under construction, so access is limited.



As of May 31, 2009, we have received payments in the amount of \$1,348,385 towards the commitment pledge of \$2,090,316. There remains an outstanding balance of \$741,931 towards the 3-year commitments made by church families. Your continued support in paying the balance due on your commitment will be greatly appreciated. We have not gone over budget on our construction project. The *budget* has remained fixed through the process.
