 Keep me safe till morning light.

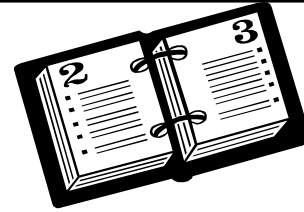
All this day thy hand has led me,

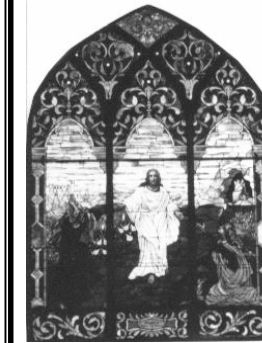
