## UNISON PRAYER OF CONFESSION

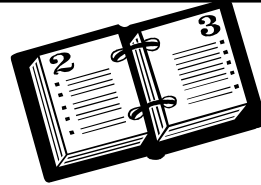

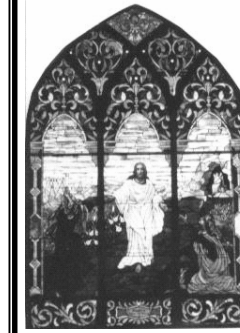
