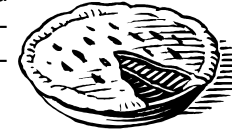

Christian Café is in need of bakers to make treats for our coffee hour. If you would like to bake for Christian Café, please contact Susyn Morales at 732-266-7734.

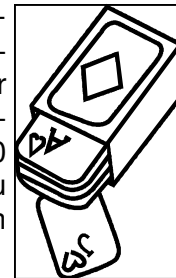

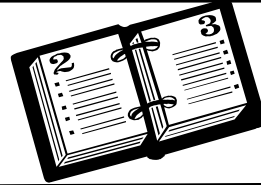

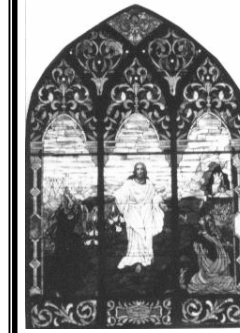
