One: We worship a Christ who is risen and alive, victorious over the powers who would try to bury him deep.

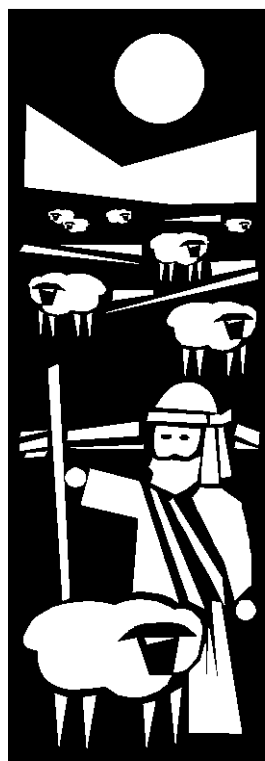

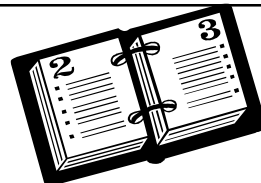

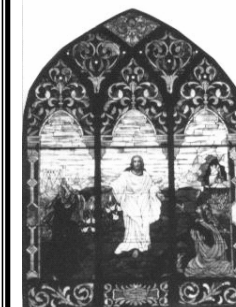
