Need a spiritual lift? Call 223-LORD. The Deacons record spiritually uplifting messages each week for those who need it. You can call any time.

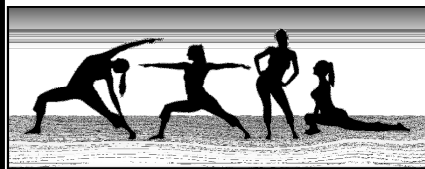

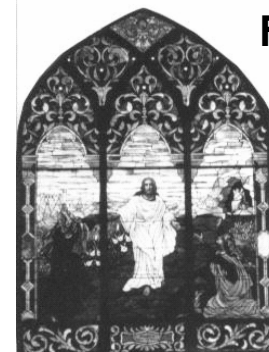
