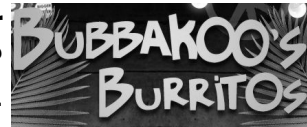

DO YOU SEE THE BANNER UP FRONT?

Last week, we shared the Presbyterian guidelines for reading and interpreting the Bible. Of all the documents, the Scriptures come first. They contain the authoritative Word of God for our lives. We come to the Bible in prayer and openness to the Holy Spirit's inspiration. Secondly, Presbyterians have the Confessions of Faith that have been written over 2000 years.

These statements give us guidance and declare our beliefs for the times in which we live. We are fortunate to have banners that symbolize these different Confessions. Last week, we displayed the banner for the Confession of 1967. In a time of intense feelings about the Vietnam War, Civil Rights and Race Relations, this Confession emphasized God's reconciliation in Jesus. Hence there were outstretched hands of all colors coming together as brothers and sisters in Christ.

This week, we display the banner for the Barmen Declaration of 1934. The Swastika is crossed out and despite the flames of persecution, the Cross of Jesus Christ reigns supreme. The fire reminds us of the suffering and death which followed the defense of the faith against tyranny. In all of life then, Jesus Christ is Lord over all. Next week, we will display the banner for the Brief Statement of Faith of 1983 and on the first of the month for the Sacrament of the Holy Supper we will display the banner for the Apostles' Creed. If you have questions or comments about these banners and Confessions of Faith, please let us know. We want our people to be informed about what we believe!

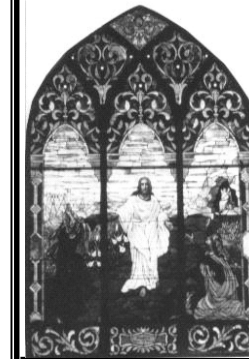
