The Self-Study & Profile Committee has two main responsibilities:

- To collect information to describe the past, present and hoped for future of Saint Michael's. The committee selects the methods it will use to do this such as interviewing, questionnaires, structured discussions at parish gatherings and review of church and city records.
- To write a Parish Profile for distribution to our rector candidates which is based upon the data accumulated in the Self-Study. This Profile summarizes the congregation's assessment of who and what it is and needs to be in the future. In addition, the Profile includes important information such as budget, parish statistics, buildings and grounds, support staff and worship.

The suggested Time-Line for the Self-Study & Parish Profile Committee is:

- The chairs meet as soon as possible to plan the committee's work, and the committee meets as soon as it can be assembled to begin its work.
- By October 15th the committee completes the questionnaire and it is sent to all parishioners via e-mail or postal mail.
- In November and December the committee tallies the survey results and identifies areas in need of more information and/or clarification. Discussions are also held in group or individually with parishioners.
- By early January, 2009 the Parish Profile is written and published to coincide with the Vestry Retreat date of January 10th.

The Search Committee's responsibilities include:

- Review all candidate résumés.
- Interview and check references on candidates they feel best match our profile.
- Communicate regularly with the Vestry and congregation about the progress of the search.
- Present the final list of candidates to the Vestry.

The suggested Time-Line for the Search Committee is:

- January 15th to May 1st begins to receive candidates' names and obtains the following for each candidate:
 - CDO profile
 - Résumé
 - Written self-statement
 - Written response to questions submitted by Search Committee
 - References

- Sends committee members to visit best candidates in their church settings.
- Arranges for reference checks by Diocesan Deployment Office.
- Gains approval from Bishop for persons on its short list of candidates.

Finally by May, 2009 the Vestry:

- Receives from the Search Committee names of final candidates.
- Interviews finalists at Saint Michael's Church.
- Advises Bishop of final selection.
- Calls a Rector.

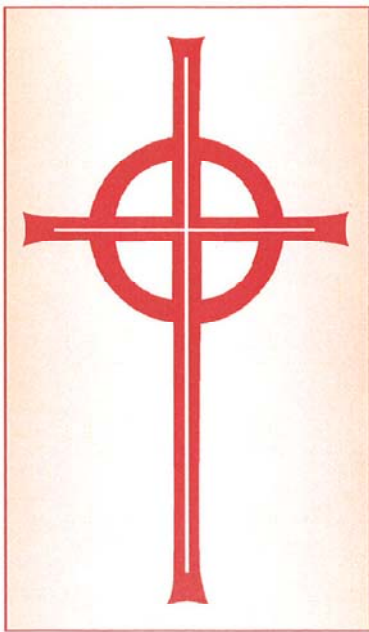
In summary, we have twenty-two talented parishioners who have volunteered to serve on the Self-Study/Parish Profile Committee and the Search Committee. Together with ten members of the Vestry, they will, along with the assistance of all parishioners who share their ideas, thoughts and prayers, help make the future of Saint Michael's all that we want it to be.

Guidelines to Serve on Search or Self-Study/Profile Committee

- *Active member of the congregation who regularly attends services.*
- *Supports the financial needs of the Parish through pledging or other documented support.*
- *Active in one or more ministries of the parish and faithful in carrying out their responsibilities.*
- *Available and willing to make a commitment to meet Search or Self-Study Committee meeting attendances responsibilities.*
- *Able and willing to put aside any pre-conceived aims or agenda items for the future of the Parish or for the selection of a Rector*

In addition, with regard to the Search Committee:

- *Able to respect the norm of absolute confidentiality that must pertain to the discernment process.*
- *Willingness to follow the Parish Profile directives as to the qualifications and kind of person the Parish wants to have in our new Rector.*
