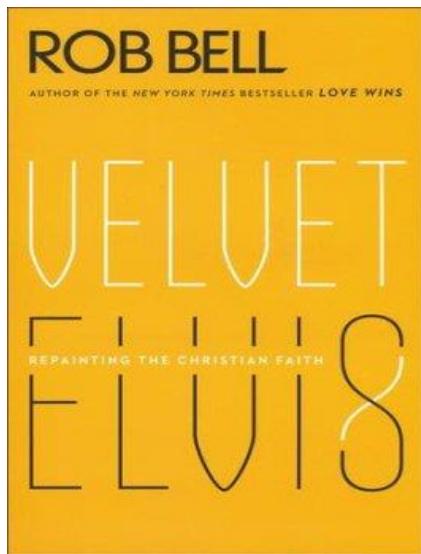

What? We will be reading/discussing *Velvet Elvis* by Rob Bell (available in print, ebook, and audiobook on Amazon).

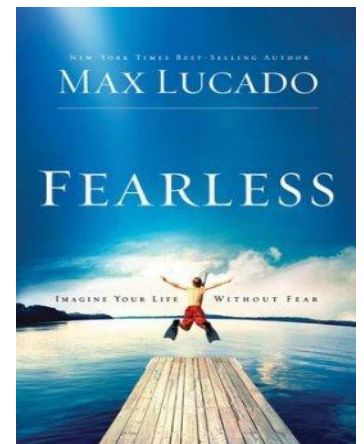

## June Collections

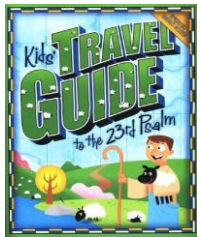

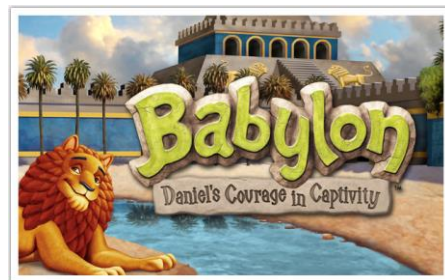
- Hydrocortisone Cream

## Children's Wednesday Night Program

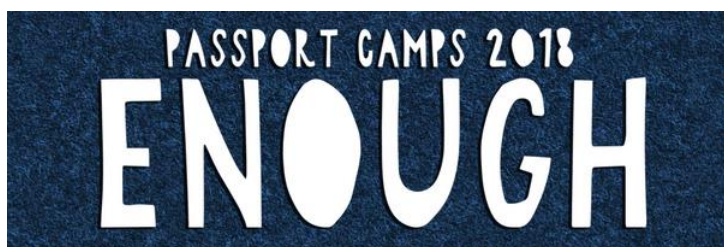
