Basic Course cost \$35 and includes:

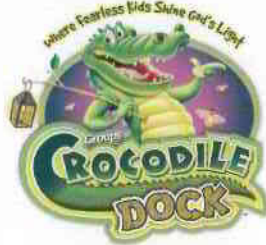
- Mass Feeding

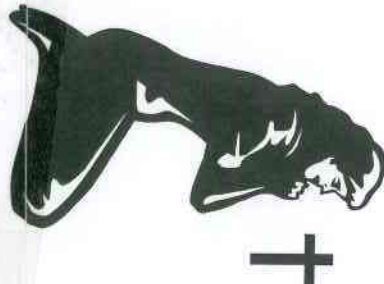
