- We will be responsible for our own meal preparations therefore will need 2 to 3 people whose only responsibilities will be cooking, shopping, etc
- Construction/repair supplies for project will be supplied by our host
- We will have one free day for sightseeing (Mt Rushmore)
- All participants will be required to attend Cultural Awareness training (date to be announced)
