In this newsletter you will find a Deacon Nomination form. The selection of deacons is so important to the life and health of a congregation. In the past, many Baptist churches have been content to use deacons as mere managers of the church's resources. Biblically, deacons are to be so much more. Deacons need to be spiritual servant leaders within the church.

A spiritual leader is not necessarily someone who is great at delegation or management, though these can be assets. A spiritual leader hears, integrates and reproduces the Word of God in the lives of other people.

The position of deacon is not one that should be sought or campaigned for. Churches get off track when the selection of deacons mirrors local elections for civic positions. People campaign for their candidate listing all of their strong qualities and reasons why they should be elected. Those who are chosen then see their position as that of an elected official representing his or her constituents. The office of deacon should never be based on a campaign but a calling that is from God and affirmed by the local church.

So, how should we select deacons? We need to pray and let God guide us in selecting those within our fellowship that he would have to serve. As we pray, we must be guided by what God's Word says concerning the qualifications of a deacon (see 1 Timothy 3:1-6).

I thank God for those who are presently serving as deacons and for their ministry among us. I pray that each of us will earnestly seek God's guidance in this important process as we select new deacons so that our deacon ministry might continue to be strong and God-honoring.
