Mission Trip Opportunity!

**Salmon Frenzy:
Beach Reach Alaskan – Style
July 16 – July 23, 2008**

Who can participate?

Any church member who is fifteen years of age or older at the time of the trip is invited to participate.

What will we be doing?

We will be working through Global Partnership Ministries targeting families who travel to the mouth of the Kenai River at a special time of the year when Resident Alaskans can dip net fish (last two weeks of July, only). This is servanthood evangelism on a beach where Alaskans are dip-netting salmon. Beach Reach, Alaskan style.

It entails organized games for kids, hotdog give-aways at lunch, evening bonfire testimonials, Sunday beach chapel, manning filet tables, sharpening filet knives, first aid station, beach cleanup, and carrying ice chest/gear for families as they arrive and depart from the beach.

Our team will serve these fishermen helping to carry their fish from the river to the parking areas, helping to clean/filet the fish, icing the fish down, holding an outdoor children's beach Bible school for the children of the fishermen. We will also give out free hot dogs, water bottle, gospel tracts and manage a first aid station. We'll

hold evening bonfire beach evangelistic rallies and a Sunday fisherman's chapel.

We will also have teams working at the Homer Fishing Lagoon and the Russian River Bridge Parking Lot ministering to sport fishermen at height of salmon run on Kenai River giving out water bottle, fishing flies on cards with gospel messages, offering free gumbo/chili meal to fishermen from tailgate of a truck. You don't have to know anything about fishing or dip netting to do this project. You just have to have a spirit that loves to help others.

How much will the trip cost?

The airfare to Alaska will be paid by the church from the RBC Mission Opportunities line item of the budget. Each participant will be required to pay \$400 to cover lodging, meals, and all ground transportation. It should be noted that lodging will be in a local church sleeping on air mattresses provided by that church. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is due by January 20, 2008. Also, Global Partnership Ministries requires that a written personal testimony be provided by each participant and sent with the deposit. A second payment of \$100 is due March 16. The remaining balance of \$200 is due no later than June 1.
